# Spiritual Gifts Evaluation

This evaluation is designed to help you discover your spiritual gifts. There are no wrong answers. All answers are right answers.

## *Instructions*

- A. Fold out the perforated **Results** card located on the inside back cover.
- B. Using your **Results** card as an answer sheet, read each question carefully. In the corresponding box, enter the number value you feel best describes you.

**Often = 3**  
**Sometimes = 2**  
**Seldom = 1**  
**Never = 0**

After you've filled in all of the boxes, we'll show you how to evaluate your responses to find out what your spiritual gifts are.

## *Let's try the first question together*

1. I easily delegate important responsibilities to others.

If your answer is **OFTEN**, write the number **3** in the box for question 1 on the **RESULTS** card.

If your answer is **SOMETIMES**, write the number **2** in the box for question 1 on the **RESULTS** card.

If your answer is **SELDOM**, write the number **1** in the box for question 1 on the **RESULTS** card.

If your answer is **NEVER**, write the number **0** in the box for question 1 on the **RESULTS** card.

Now go to question 2 and complete it in the same way (*Note: The results box for question 2 is below the box for question 1*).
