Core Responsibilities:

1. Weekend Ministry (45%)

- Coordinate weekend Grade School and Club 56 ministries, ensuring the mission, vision and strategy for discipleship is implemented.
- Weekend Children's Ministry supervision (2-3x per month), with occasional classroom leading when needed.
- Edit and prepare curriculum for weekly Grade School and Club 56 lessons and activities.
- Maintain classroom environments, organize toys and supplies, and ensure items are clean and in good condition.

2. Volunteer Care and Oversight (25%)

- Recruit and train volunteers for Grade School ministry and Club 56.
- Work with Children's Ministry Pastor on volunteer development & care events.
- Support, celebrate, and connect with volunteer team.
- Assist Children's Ministry Pastor with Safe Ministry screening.

3. Discipling Families (25%)

- Support and coordinate Kids' Worship ministry with volunteer team.
- Organize and implement parent equipping with Children's Ministry Team.
- Plan and implement Club 56 events with volunteer team.
- Help organize, plan, and execute Southview day camps in the summer.
- Prepare Grade School activities for Family Worship Weekends



• Organize and implement family events with direction from the Children's Ministry Pastor.

4. Staff Team (5%)

- Participate in weekly Children's Ministry team meetings and planning days.
- Participate in monthly one-on-one meetings with the Children's Ministry Pastor.
- Participate in regular all-staff meetings and events.
